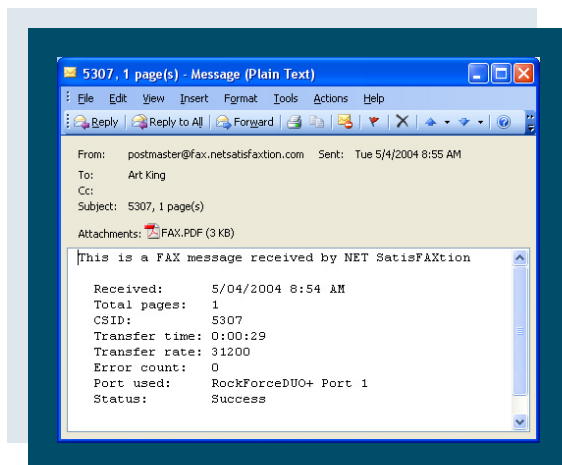
Receive Incoming Faxes as PDF's

Introduction

The NET SatisFAXtion PDF Convert Module allows you to take advantage of the universally popular Acrobat Portable Document Format (PDF) file. The module is an add-on option to the NET SatisFAXtion fax server line and works by automatically converting incoming faxes directly to a PDF file format.

From Fax to PDF Instantly!

Now email users can receive inbound fax images as PDF file directly to their Microsoft Outlook, Lotus Notes or any SMTP Internet mail client inbox. From any email inbox, incoming faxes appear as PDF files, which can be easily opened reliably across a broad range of hardware and software, and appear just like the original file.



How it Works

With the PDF Convert Module, a NET SatisFAXtion fax server can be configured to convert incoming fax images on-the-fly to a PDF format. Unlike other document conversion solutions, the PDF add-on option DOES NOT require any manual intervention and is a function handled by the fax server automatically.

Whatever method of inbound routing you choose, the PDF Convert Module converts incoming faxes to PDF's when either auto-routed directly to users or manually routed. NET SatisFAXtion supports a wide range of inbound fax routing methods including AIR (automatic inbound routing), CSID, (Call subscriber identification), DID (Direct inward dial), line routing and manual routing.
